



# Academic Performance 2015

## Early Years:

All pupils at the end of the Reception year are assessed by their class teacher against the Early Learning Goals in 17 different areas. Pupils are judged to have reached a 'Good level of Development' if they are working at the expected level in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development, physical development and communication and language) and the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

## Key Stage One:

Pupils are assessed in the subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths at the end of Year Two. Key Stage One SAT tests are used to inform the teacher's assessments. We are proud of the increases we have made from 2013 and we are delighted we are working ever closer to National Standards.

## Key Stage Two:

Year Six pupils sit National tests at the end of the year with Level 4 being the National expectation. The pupils sit tests in reading, grammar and spelling, and maths. Their writing level is evidenced from their extended writing across the year. The impact of the whole school focus on reading last year is especially evident in Key Stage Two:
