We have launched 'No Outsiders' this half-term. The children have engaged with this really important theme already through weekly assemblies and half-termly lessons linked to literature.

LKS2 looked at the book 'Oliver' and thought of ways that they were different to others. UKS2 looked at the book 'The Whisperer' which promoted deep reflection and discussion around the topic of discrimination.
